

Pickerington Public Library COVID-19: By the Numbers Report



Sharing knowledge since 1907.

NATIONAL

- **99 percent** of Americans have not tested positive for COVID-19.
- Of the 54 million people tested, **90 percent were negative for COVID.**
- The most recent CDC weekly update showed a 1-2 percent decrease in overall cases (the midwest had a slight uptick).

STATE: OHIO

- 2 percent of the total national cases are from Ohio.
- Tests have increased to **16,000 - 30,000 daily** since late April early May showing **94 percent of tests on a daily bases are negative.**
- **27 percent of cases** are from Long Term Care facilities or health care workers. 90 percent of the mortality rate is attributed to people 60+.

COUNTY: FRANKLIN & FAIRFIELD

- **99.94 percent** of Fairfield has not tested positive for COVID-19. Of those who have it, **98 percent survive.** **99 percent** of Franklin has not tested positive for COVID-19. Of those who have it, **97 percent survive.** **The majority** of cases are also attributed to Long Term Care facilities and health care workers.

BY ZIPCODE: Pickerington, Canal Winchester, Reynoldsburg, Baltimore

- **99 percent of the total population** has not tested positive for COVID-19. Overall, case and mortality rate is significantly lower than state and national rates. .01 percent of the state cases have come from this area.

CDC & STATE RECOMMENDATIONS

- Recommendations for Franklin and Fairfield County: At the third level (or red), continued spread is expected over the next week in both counties, supports decreased interactions, travel only when necessary and limited gatherings.
- Battelle has completed multiple studies on library materials to determine risk of spread, recommending a 3-4 day quarantine depending on the item.
